Hi everyone – hope this finds you safe and well! A couple of updates from Health Canada.


1. I raised the issue of the new fee form not allowing a \$0 entry for administrative changes. Here is Health Canada's response.

"For the time being, if you wish to make an administrative amendment you can omit submitting a fee form with your application and in its place include a rationale in your cover letter justifying an administrative amendment that is not subject to any fees. In addition to the cover letter you can also leave a note in the fee form section of the folder structure, reiterating your rationale, to minimize any further complications."

2. The list of critical devices for COVID-19 shortage reporting is being amended and is expected in the next few days. Please send me suggestions for changes to the form so that Health Canada can amend the form to make it more useful to medical device reporting.
